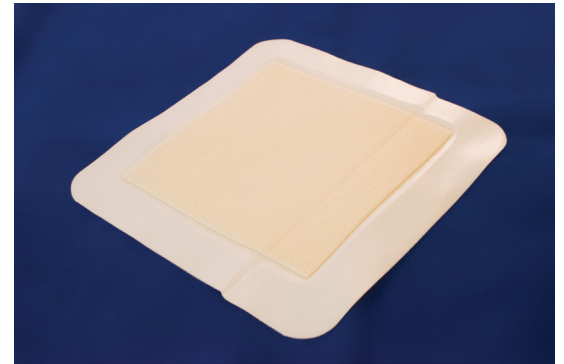


ADHESIVE FOAM DRESSING

Description

This high-density foam dressing is covered by a layer of comfortable, self-adhesive, water-resistant polyurethane foam. This foam backing helps maintain an optimally moist wound environment, helps prevent strike-through, and aids in the prevention of bacterial contamination of the wound. The moisture vapor transmission rate adjusts depending on the fluid level in the wound. The foam pad has micropores for low adherence to the wound surface, yet has a higher fluid-handling capacity than other brands. The foam island gently expands as it absorbs, keeping the dressing in contact with the wound surface for improved fluid handling.
